



# CITIZENS' COUNCILS ON CLIMATE (PL)

#### **PROJECT OBJECTIVES**

- to include the inhabitants in the process of deciding the climate policy of their municipality
- supporting municipalities in the creation of strategic climate documents with the participation of inhabitants
- pilot use and adaptation of a participation tool that is not very popular in Poland: citizen juries and citizens' assemblies for the needs of small and medium-sized cities.





## CITIZENS' COUNCILS ON CLIMATE (PL)

#### **ACTIVITIES:**

- 1. Phase of the Citizens' Climate Lab (November 2021-August 2022) consultation processes for strategic climate related documents carried out in 4 municipalities using the citizens' jury method.
- survey on the topic
- simplified sortition of participants
- expert diagnosis of local policies and definition of key issues for the council
- local citizens' councils (education, deliberation and online voting on recommendations)
- 1. Phase of the National Climate Citizens' Meeting (August 2022-December 2023) approximately 20 citizens' councils with expert support and using the materials developed after the Laboratory.

- Methodology: CITIZENS' ASSEMBLIES, Guide to democracy that works by Marcin Gerwin
- Number of Participants: 30

- Participants
  - 30 residents
    - 13 women and 17 men
    - 18-24 years: 5 people
    - 25-39 years: 10 people
    - 40-64: 10 people
    - 65 years and over: 5 people

- Education
  - Primary education: 1
  - Secondary vocational education: 1
  - Higher secondary ed: 1
  - 1 Full secondary education: 9
  - University education: 18
  - 28 people at all meetings

- Proposals
  - Increase the proportion of urban green space
  - Urban parks and green belts
  - Suggestion that green spaces should be prioritised and protected in the new masterplan
  - Increase the capture and use of rainwater

- Reduce potable water consumption
- Green roofs and indoor water features
- Transparency in communicating about climate change
- Practical education in schools


