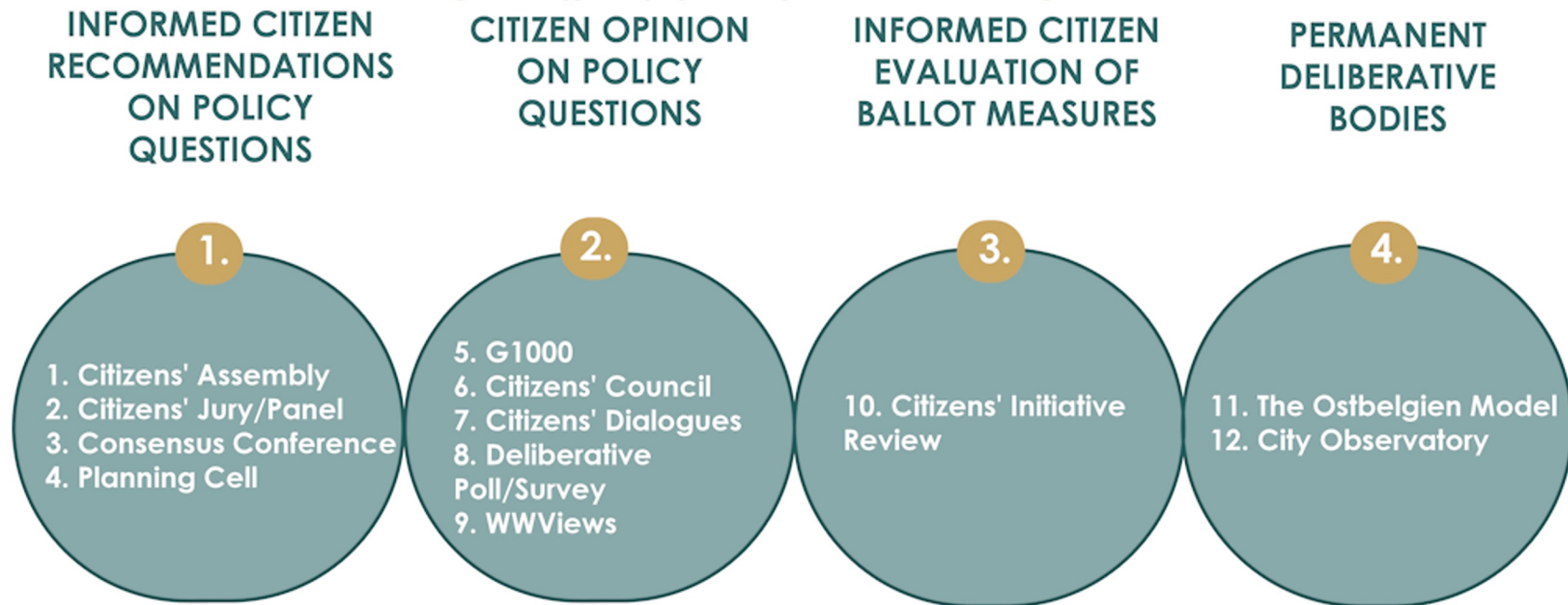

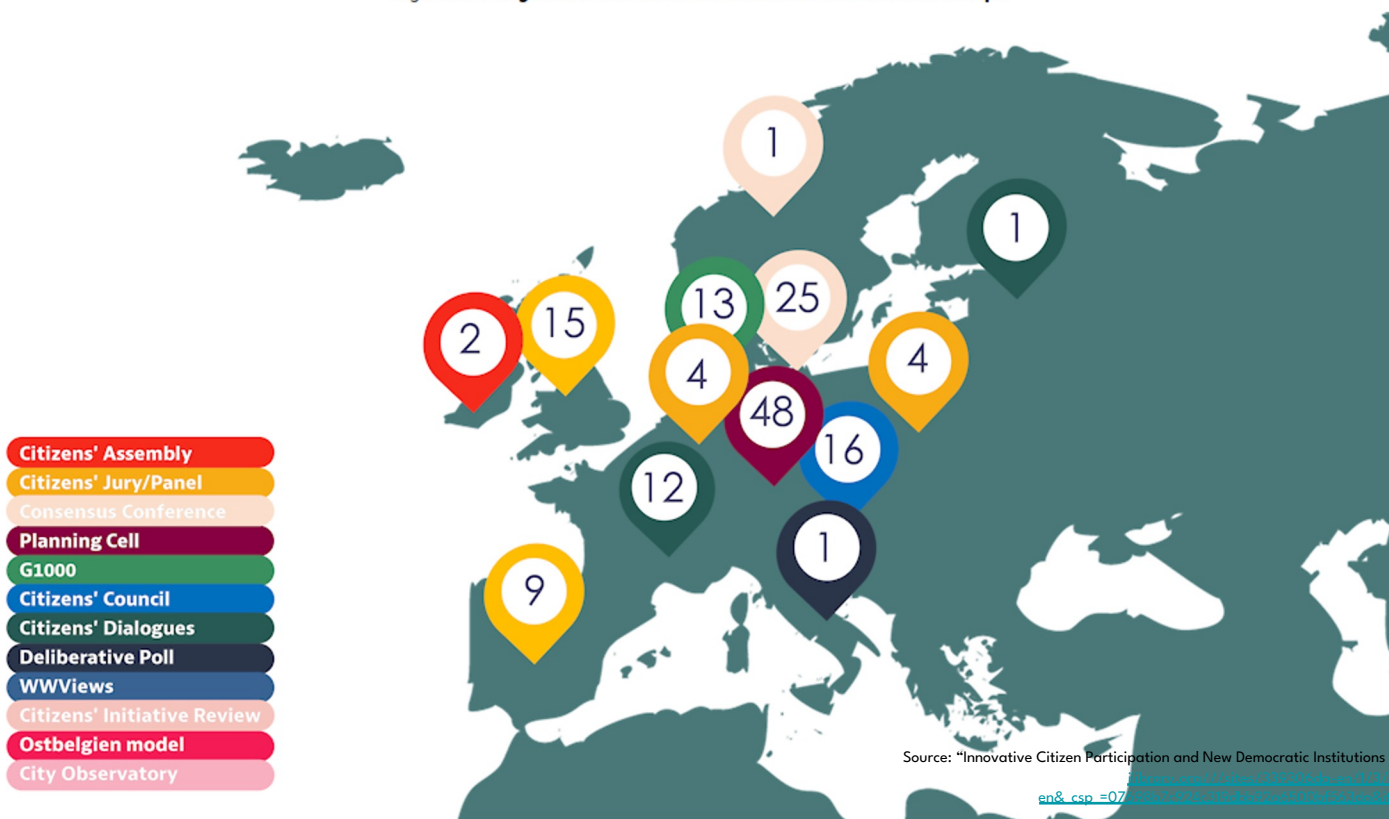

Figure 2.1. Types of purpose of representative deliberative processes

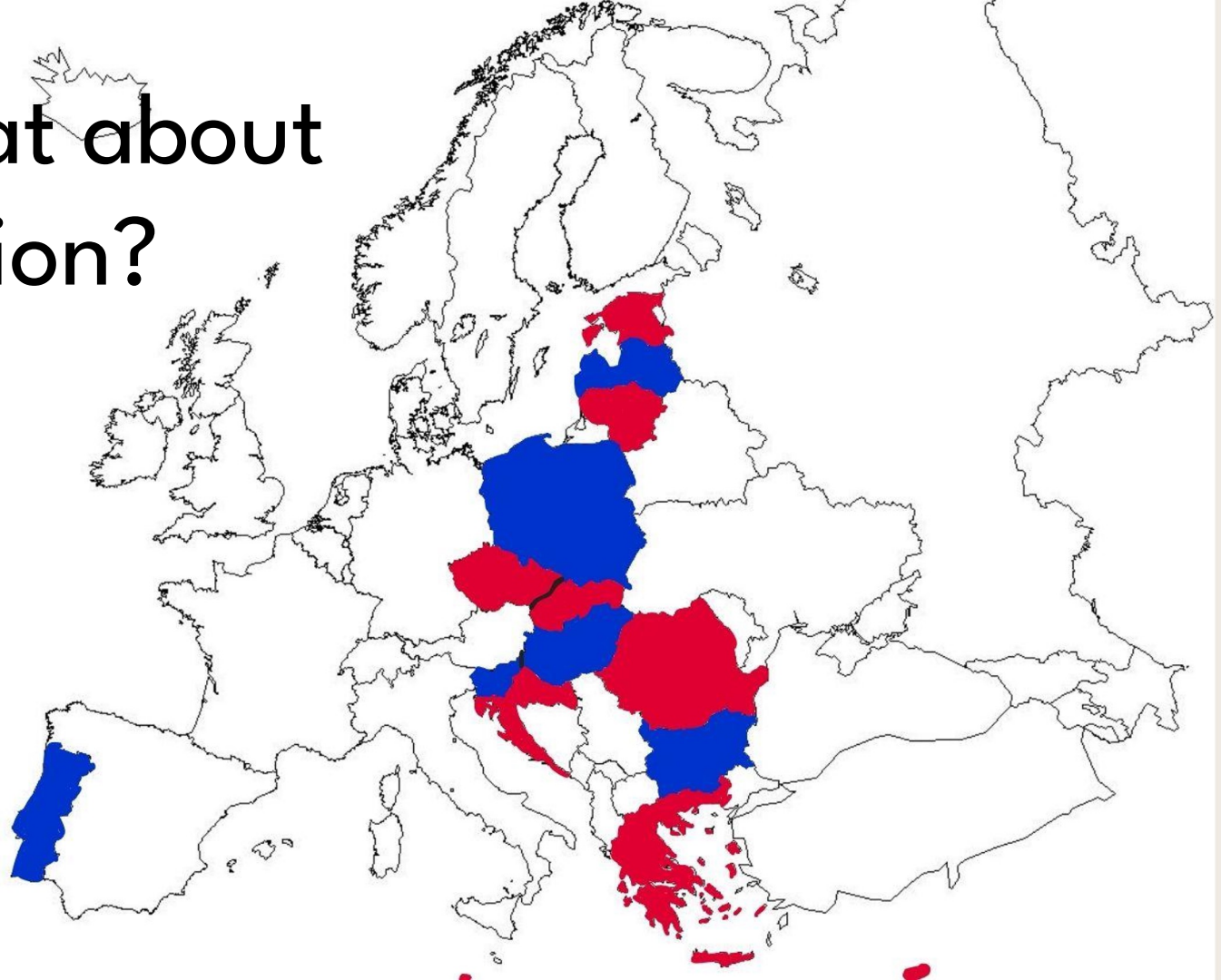

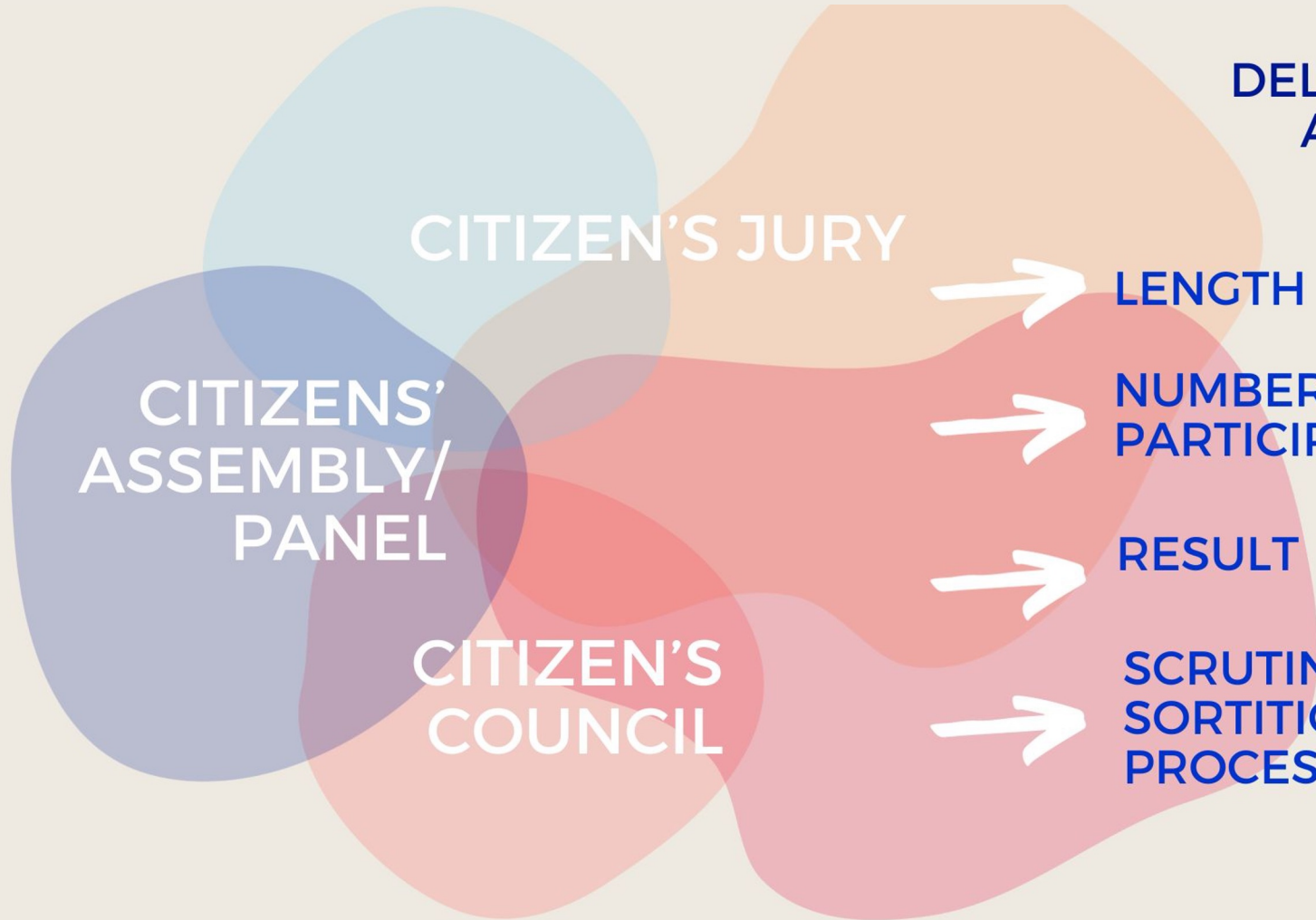
